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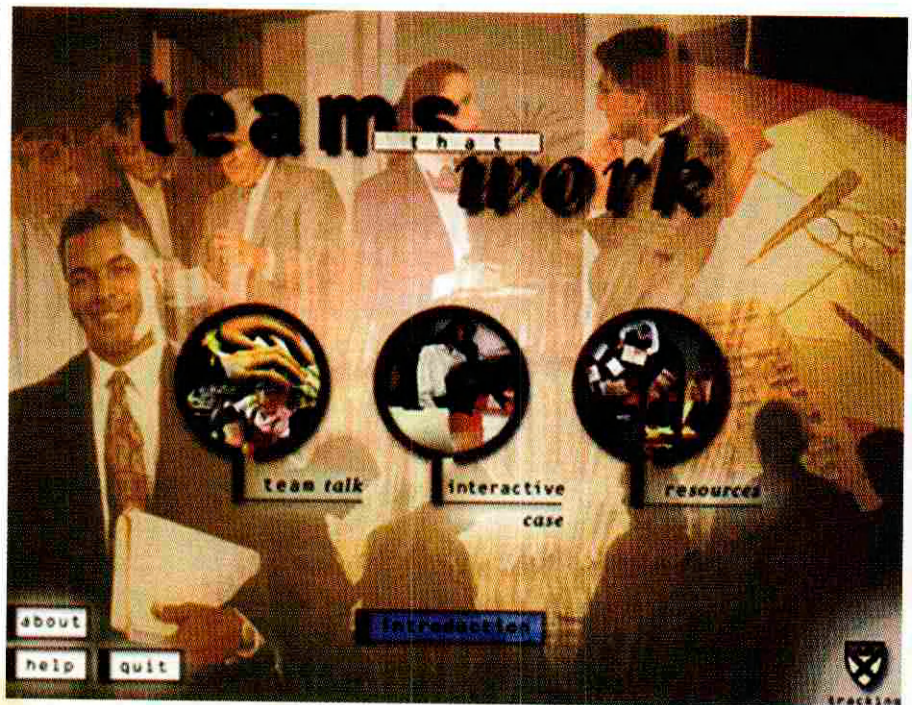
TEAMS THAT WORK CD-ROM

Harvard Business School's *Teams That Work* CD-ROM is designed to help managers maximize team performance.

The program is divided into three modules: Team Talk, Interactive Case, and Resources. In Interactive Case, managers navigate using a built-in appointment calendar to listen to voice messages, read e-mail and memos, follow meeting agendas and notes, and watch videos of teams interacting. Then, they make decisions for the teams in the video.

The Resources module includes articles from *Harvard Business Review*, notes and cases from the Harvard Business School collection of teaching materials, as well as worksheets and checklists for identifying and managing team problems.

Teams That Work is available for IBM-compatible PCs with 12MB of RAM recommended. Drivers must be compatible with QuickTime for Windows 2.0. A SoundBlaster or compatible sound card and Microsoft



Windows 3.1 or later is required.

Pricing is based on the number of users and begins at approximately \$450 per seat for 25 to 49 users. For

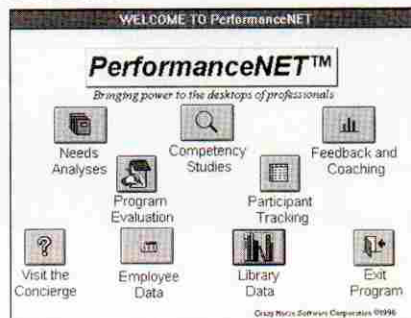
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PERFORMANCE NET

The book provides techniques for achieving fulfillment in those essential elements of one's being: the heart, the mind, and the soul.

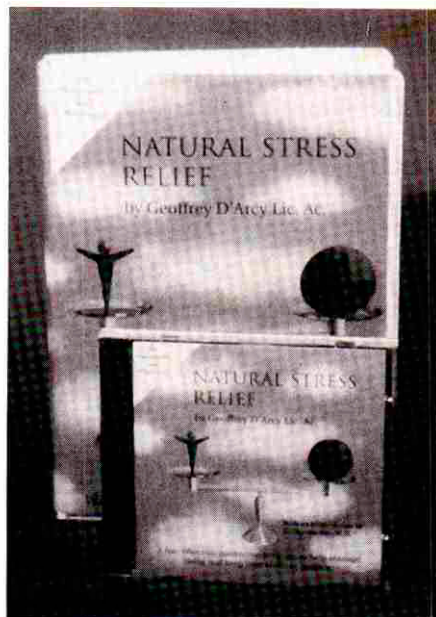
