

Second Generation CRT Image-Recording Outfit

An outfit that enables users to make instant color prints of images created on a 9-, 12-, 13- or 19-inch computer terminal is available from Eastman Kodak Company.

The Kodak Instagraphic CRT print imager is a modular system that provides flexibility in the documentation of still images displayed on a video or computer screen. In addition to its instant printmaking capability, the imager can be used to produce conventional color slides and prints of the video image by using a 35mm singlelens-reflex camera, not provided with the outfit.

The imager's camera and lightgathering cone unit attach to any of

photograph computer graphics displayed on 9-, 12-, 13- or 19-inch video terminals. The camera unit provides the correct lens-to-screen focal length and partially corrects for screen distortion.
