Chapter Services has received reports of issues with the data integration that updates chapter membership databases. Specific membership and contact fields are required to facilitate the transfer of information between systems. # **Maintaining Data Integration Between the** ATD Store and WildApricot

A key element of the Chapter Membership on the ATD Store program—which allows chapters to sell their memberships via td.org—is the API integration between ATD's association management system and each chapter's WildApricot site. This connection allows the two systems to transfer member information back and forth. For example, if a new member joins the chapter via td.org, that member's information will appear in the chapter's membership database because of this integration.

Chapter Services has received a few reports of issues with this data integration in recent months. In most cases, these issues were caused by changes to the contact and membership fields. These fields store information about all contacts in the system (first name, last name, email) and specific membership information (membership level, renewal date). For the integration to work properly, certain fields must be included and marked as required in the chapter's WildApricot settings. The deletion of required fields or even small changes in field names can cause the integration to break down. You can find a complete list of required fields and guidance on how to update them here.

As a best practice, we recommend conducting a monthly audit of the chapter's membership records. Each chapter has a designated contact (usually the VP membership or chapter administrator) that receives a weekly roster listing the individuals who joined or renewed in the past week. It's important that a member of the chapter board compares this roster with the chapter's membership database to ensure all records are accurate and up to date.
