Sticky Presentations

Kroy has added the 240SE to its DuraType series of portable systems that simplify technical drawings for presentations.

The self-contained 240SE—about the size of a desktop calculator can be used to label a drawing, computer disk, videotape, or threering binder (using vertical printing). It can also create headlines or add sequential numbers to finished technical drawings used in presentations by engineers, architects, and designers.

The 4-pound 240SE has a "QWERTY" keyboard and 16-character liquid crystal display, which prints in a range of typestyles and type sizes. The built-in thermal printer produces lettering on halfinch-wide strips of adhesive-backed clear tape with black letters and on opaque white tape with black, red, or blue letters. The tape is laminated inside the machine.

The 240SE features a repeat key for repetitive text and numbers. The user can also edit, insert, or replace text with one function key. There is a backspace key for erasures. Special font variations include underline, outline, drop shadow, framing, and negative (light-on-dark image).

The exterior design forms its own carrying case. Slots on the inside of the cover store small font cards that are smaller than credit cards. Just slip the selected font card into a slot above the keyboard to change

the type style.

For global presenters, the 240SE generates characters for Western European languages; a special switch allows the screen prompts to be displayed in English, French, or German.

The print buffer holds 256 characters of data, retained in memory until you turn off the


