Without chemicals or a darkroom, lineless prints are created which display full detail in shadows and highlights.

Instructional developers can use the CT1500 to prepare artwork for workbooks and manuals. By using the printer, developers avoid the cost and time associated with outside design services. The CT1500 is also beneficial for group discussion visuals. It creates overhead transparencies from training videos or character generators. By inserting a film cassette into the printer in regular room light, instructional developers can produce transparencies, again in 18 seconds and with no darkroom products or facilities.

Programs Pass Muster?

A "consumers' report" on the leading 100 management development programs is now available from Corporate Education Resources (CER). The CER Evaluation Guide to Executive Programs combines software and print to create a helpful tool for choosing executive programs.

The guide goes beyond program suppliers and costs; it provides the qualitative information necessary for matching executive needs with executive programs. Programs are evaluated from four different perspectives-that of program attendees, the CER editorial staff, the human resources community and the guide's author, former program manager of executive development for IBM.

If the typical cost for a four-to-sixweek management development program doesn't get you-\$6,000 to \$8,000—the overwhelming cost of assessing a wide variety of them will, according to the guide's author. So the \$500 cost of the guide may well be worth the investment. The book may be purchased alone for \$150, but here's the benefit of buying the whole package: The software answers questions instantaneously, and it answers more specific questions than the book does. You can ask, for instance, what general management courses with strength in economics are available in the Northeast, lasting no more than six weeks and costing less then \$10,000. And get your answer quickly. A manual search for such information might take quite some time, assuming all the data was available. The CER computerized search takes just seconds.


