### Mandatory IRS Filing Requirements Deadline May 15

Chapters must file [990/990-N forms](#) every year by the 15th day of the fifth month after the close of the chapter's tax year. For most chapters, this will be May 15, 2023, for the 2022 tax year. Remember that any information received about taxes should be verified directly with the IRS. Chapter services request each chapter submit a copy of their 2022 filed 990 or 990-N, along with a copy of the IRS' confirmation [via this online form.](#)

### NAC Application

The mission of the NAC is to serve as advisors, advocates, and mentors in partnership with ATD staff on matters of chapter management and operations to ensure high-quality service to members. Selected NAC members serve a three-year term. Please note that you must have been a Chapter President to be eligible to apply to NAC. The application deadline is June 5, 2023.

ATD Chapter Services' mission is to assist chapters and support their needs. A key process for chapters is the **Chapter Affiliation Requirements (CARE)** survey. Listed below are tools chapters can use to stay on track for CARE achievement.

- Track the chapter's progress throughout the year with the **CARE Foundational and Plus Planner**
  - Use the **Joint Membership Job Aid** to plan ten joint membership activities. Many chapters do some of these activities regularly including displaying the Power Member logo on the chapter website, mentioning Power Membership at the start of events, highlighting Power Memberships in chapter event slides, participating ATD Store program, and discussing Power Membership at board meetings.

### Chapter of the Month: Greater Twin Cities

Greater Twin Cities is the Chapter of the Month for improving member engagement and fostering connections within the chapter by starting monthly, facilitated small group discussions. The discussion topics allowed chapter leaders to get a better idea of emerging professional challenges impacting their membership and tailor programming to those needs, while skilled facilitation encouraged members to take ownership of new projects. As a result, the chapter has increased general member engagement, developed two new communities of practice led by program participants, and recruited a volunteer liaison to focus on new member onboarding.


