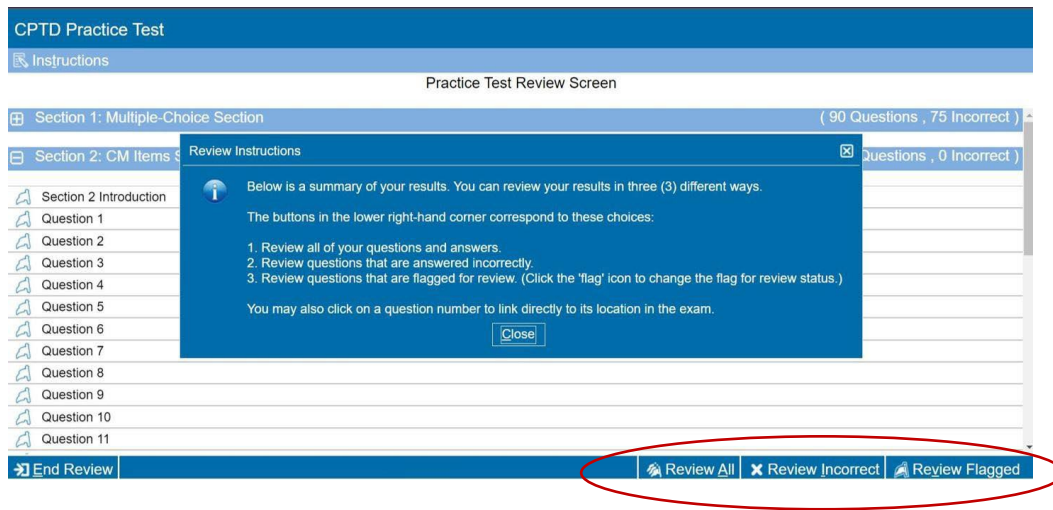


## Step-by-Step Instructions for Reviewing the Practice Test

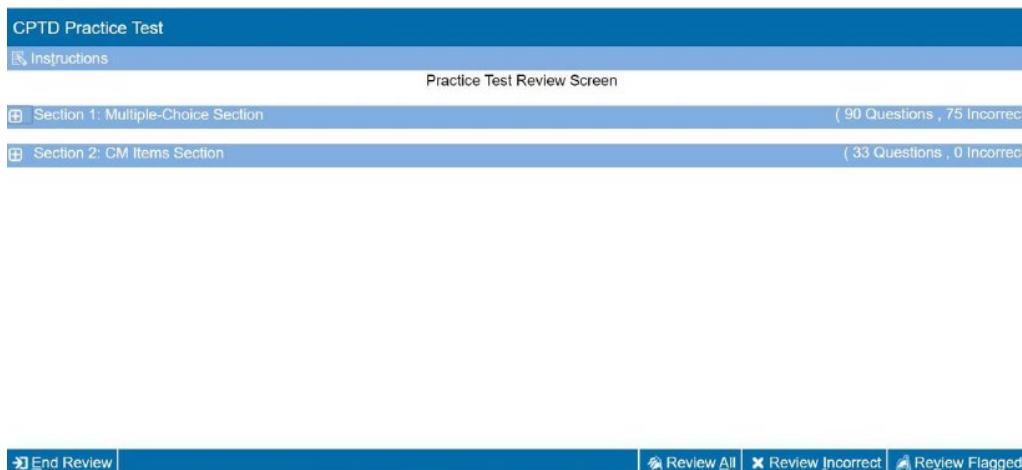
Once the user completes the actual timed portion of the Practice Test, the Practice Test review screen opens. There are three ways to review: “Review All”, “Review Incorrect”, and “Review Flagged” questions.

### View the APTD or CPTD Review Screen



### CPTD Only

For the CPTD Practice Test, there is an option to first review the multiple-choice questions or the case management questions. For the APTD Practice Test, only the multiple-choice screen will appear.



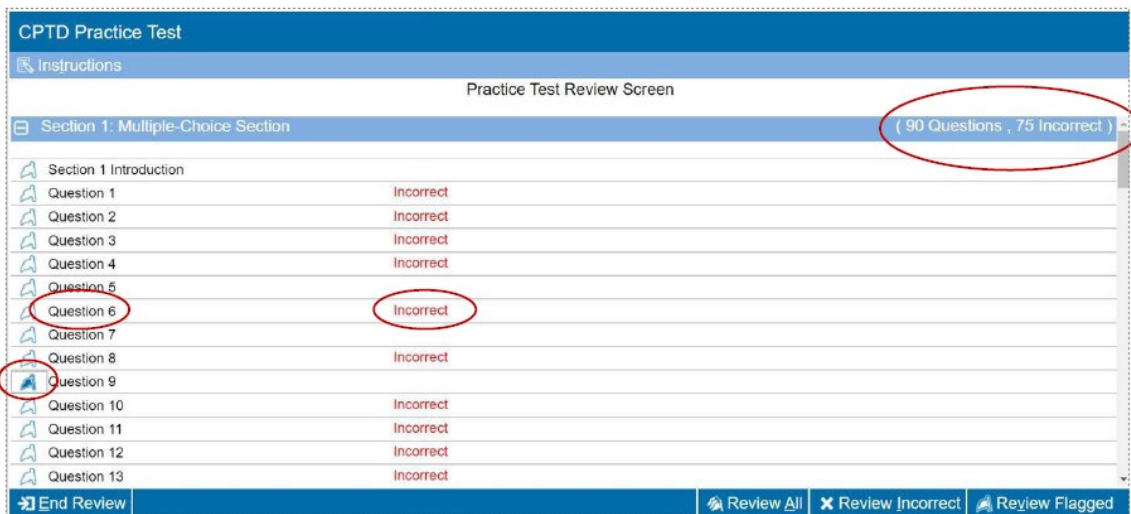
## Review Feedback for Each Question

The user will be taken to screen with the list of questions for review. At the upper right corner, the screen shows how many total questions were in this section, and how many were answered INCORRECTLY.

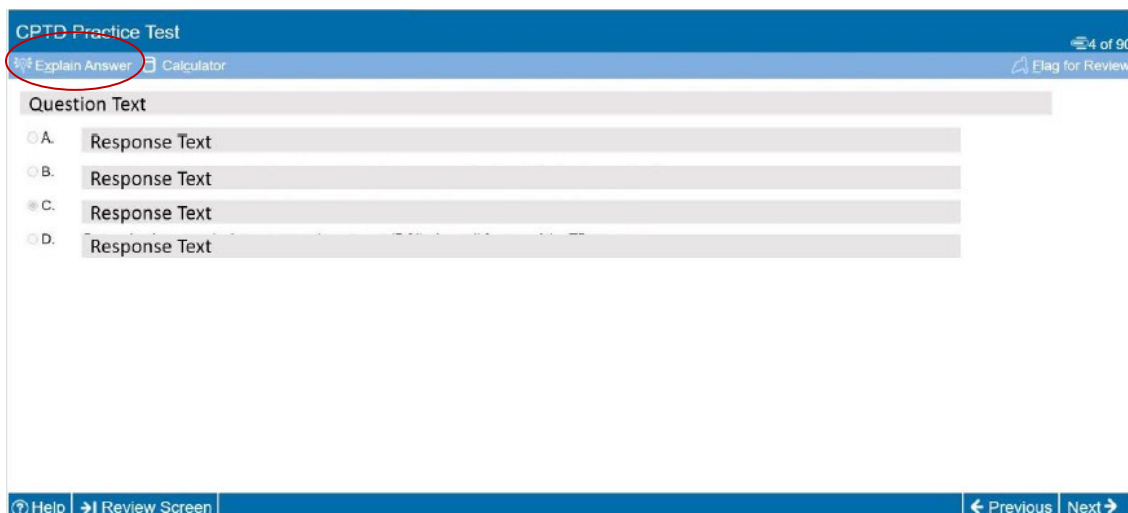
The highlighted “flag” icon on the left, indicates a question the user flagged for review.

In the center of the screen is the indication of which questions were answered INCORRECTLY.

Users can click on the specific question they wish to review, i.e. “Question 6”.




After clicking on the Question, a new screen opens to display the question for review. Click “Explain Answer” in the upper left corner to display the correct answer and the rationale for the correct answer.



## View the Correct Answer and Rationale

The correct answer with an explanation is displayed. Note the scroll bar, to view the full explanation.



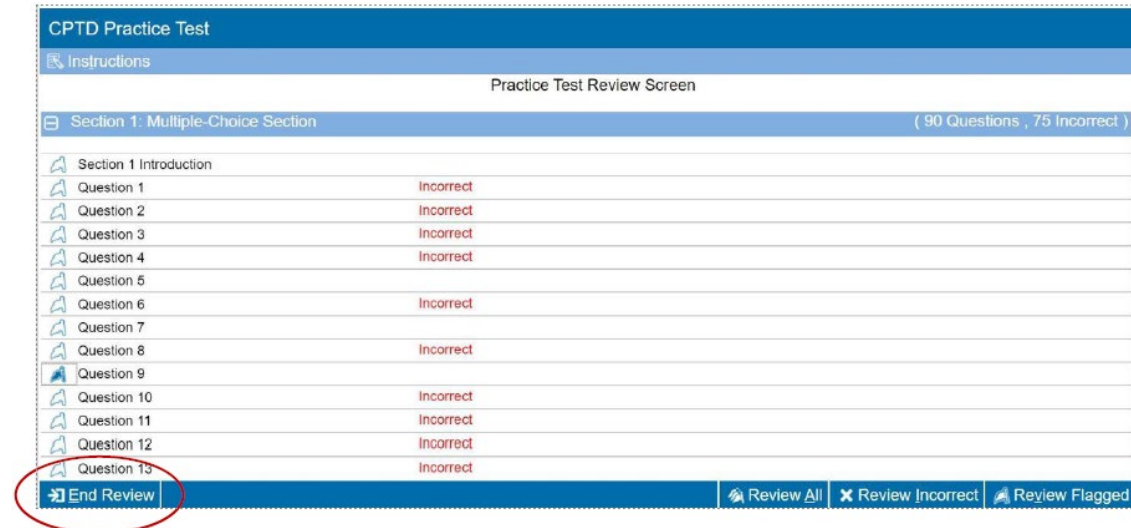

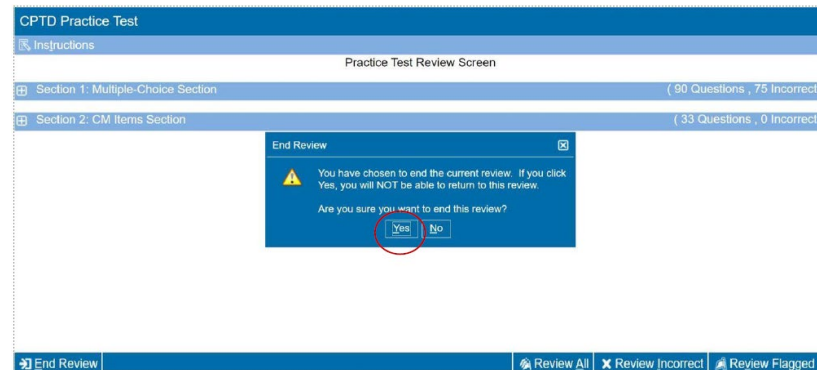

## Generate a Score Report

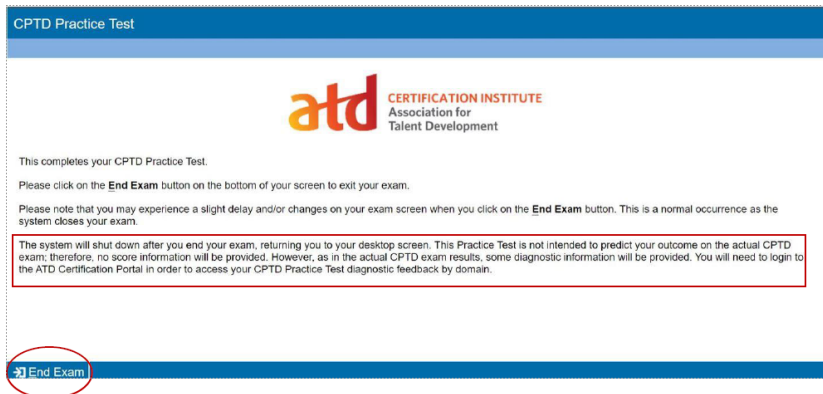
When the user has completed the review, a score report can be generated. This report recommends a level of review for each domain of practice. The user **MUST** click “End Review” in the lower left corner.



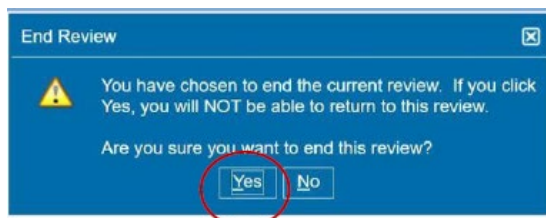
The next screen asks the user to confirm they wish to end their review.



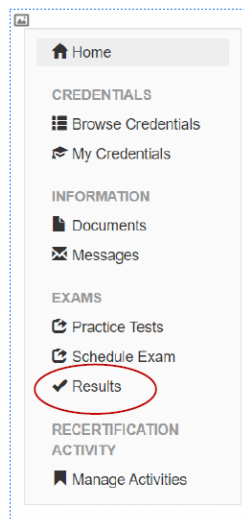
On the final screen, the user should note that performance on the Practice Test is not designed to predict performance or outcomes on the actual, scored exam. Click “End Exam” in the lower left corner to log out of the exam.



The platform will ask the user to confirm they wish to end the entire Practice Test exam session.



### Access the Score Report in the Certification Portal



To review a high-level diagnostic score report by domain of practice covered on the Practice Test, return to the ATD CI Certification Portal. Click the “Results” section on the left-hand navigation of the Certification Portal

Once in the “Results” screen, users can access their diagnostic report via PearsonVue. To download the score report, click on the “Pearson VUE” link.

## Score Report Examples

There are three levels of recommended review:

1. “Continued Review Recommended” is the least amount of review suggested for higher-performing areas.
2. “Moderate Improvement is Required” is the amount of review noted for those areas that still need improvement for success.
3. “Significant Improvement is Required” is the amount of review noted for those areas where performance on the content fell well below anticipated levels for success.
