

# **ASTD Board Team Building Activities**

① Title: Personalizing Your License Plate



Materials Needed: 2 sheets of paper and writing/drawing tools (aka crayons)

Activity – create a license plate that would represent you and one that represents you on the board

- Create your own personalized license plate use the entire page
- Create your ASTD personalized license plate use the entire page

Share with team what your license plate represents, 1 at a time

Time Need: 30 minutes



2 Title: Text It To Me – We Need To Keep In Touch

**Purpose:** Exercise demonstrates the need for the entire board to have each other's contact information, especially cell phones number so we can keep in touch with each other today and moving forward.

Materials Needed: Cell Phone

#### **Activity Instructions:**

- Person sitting next to, swap contact information, emails, cell phone numbers, etc..
- Take a picture of the person (if you have a phone with a camera) and save them on their contact information
- Ask the other 2 individuals across from you their cell phone numbers and do the same as above
- Ask the 2 individuals behind you their cell phone number and do the same
- At this time everyone should have 5 new contacts
- Now determine who's contact information you do not have and obtain it only by having someone else send you via text the name and number be creative how to accomplish this
- At this end of this activity you need to have 11 ASTD contacts

Time Needed: 30 minutes

③ **Title:** Paper Tearing – Communication "Are we on the same page"

**Purpose:** Exercise demonstrates the need to all be on the same page with solid communication

**Goal:** We all hear and execute differently. If it is important that we do it only in one, specific way, then make sure our communication is crystal clear regarding the process.

Materials Needed: Paper

#### **Activity Instructions:**

- Close your eyes
  - o RULES:
    - no peaking during the activity
    - No questions or talking to each other is allowed, only the instructors voice
- Fold the paper in half again
- Tear off the top right corner
- Fold the paper in half again
- Tear off the bottom left hand corner
- Unfold
- Open your eyes
  - O Does your look like your neighbors?

Discussion as group – why not? (depending which way you fold the paper the tears are in different areas) It makes a difference long way or short way ect....

How might this apply to our organization? This can be area directed or general and this discussion can last varying amounts of time. So the mediator must manage the discussion for the time allotted.

Time Needed: 15 minutes – 30 minutes depending on follow up discussion points
