"Tony" Franzolino, who became national Secretary-Treasurer of ASTD on June 1, is 36 years old, stands six feet two inches, has brown eyes, brown hair and weighs 200 pounds. His home is Dallas, Texas.

He is a graduate of Ohio State University with a Bachelor of Science in Commerce (1939-43) and a Master of Science in Economics and Personnel Administration (1946-47). Since 1949 he has held an Assistant Professorship of Personnel Administration at Southern Methodist University.

In addition to his teaching Tony has a full time job as Training Director for

the Temco Aircraft Corporation in Dallas, a position he has held since July 1951. Before that he was Assistant Training Supervisor at the Consolidated-Vultee Aircraft Corporation in Fort Worth and before that he was Assistant to the Training Director at the Cleveland Illuminating Company, Cleveland, Ohio.

During the War years, 1943-46, Tony served in the Army as a First Lieutenant.

His introduction to ASTD came during his stay in Cleveland where he was a member of the Northern Ohio Chapter and edited the Chapter's paper. After affiliating with the North Texas Chapter in 1951, he served as Chairman of the Program Committee, Chairman of the Research Committee, President of the Chapter (54-55) and Chairman of the Chapter's Board of Directors (1955-56). For the National ASTD he was Chairman of the National Convention Sites Committee (1954-55) and Vice-President of Region III (1955-56).

Other organizations to which he belongs include the Dallas Personnel Association, the National Association of Foremen and the TEMCO Management Club. He is a thirty-second degree Mason.

Tony and his wife live at 6830 Glendora Avenue, Dallas, and are proud of their fine family of three children.
